### Blessing of Easter Baskets

Saturday, March 30th at 10am

The blessing of Easter baskets on Holy Saturday is a cherished practice, deeply rooted in Polish and Ukrainian culture, symbolizing the beginning of Easter. It is a time when families prepare and bless special food items that reflect the richness of our Christian faith and cultural heritage. On Holy Saturday, families gather to prepare their Easter baskets, each item carefully chosen to represent the promises of Easter. Beautifully decorated and covered with a white linen cloth, these baskets are brought to church to be blessed. The contents of the baskets carry symbolic meanings:

- Eggs (pisanki) symbolize new life and Christ's resurrection
- Bread, often a sweet bread called "paska" or "babka," represents Jesus, the Bread of Life
- Ham or Sausage, symbols of great joy and abundance in celebrating Christ's resurrection
- Salt, signifying purification and the necessity of life
- Horseradish, representing the bitter sacrifice of Christ
- Butter, often shaped into a lamb (Baranek Wielkanony), symbolizing the goodness of Christ that we should emulate.

The blessing of the Easter baskets is a poignant moment. It reflects our gratitude for all God's gifts and the sacrifice of His Son for our salvation. It is a communal celebration of thanksgiving and a reaffirmation of our faith.

## St. Mary's Easter Egg Hunt

The Easter Egg Hunt will be held following Mass on Easter Sunday. After Mass, the children will process out with their Easter baskets and follow Monsignor to the statue of St. Joseph in the graveyard to have their Easter baskets blessed. We will then let the little ones under 5 years have a five minute head start on the hunt, to be followed by older children.

Parents are asked to please bring some eggs filled with candy to hide before Mass. Please drop them off in the Sacristy anytime.
