Spiritual Reflection

-- Fr. Dennis O'Donnell of Amigos de Jesus

Today's first Reading from Acts of the Apostles describes "a violent rushing wind." Pope Francis in one of his homilies accurately translates it as a "jolt." A "jolt" of wind, Breath, Spirit where "something incredibly new happens." Cowards a few days before are now courageously speaking in a language for all to understand; ignorant followers are now sent forth as erudite proclaimers of God's Word; peasant fishermen are now "fishers of all people." The mighty Breath of God has jolted a new life in the followers of Jesus Christ.

In today's Gospel of John the disciples are in a locked room externally and internally, and Jesus Christ "unlocks" the room they are in and the rooms of their hearts; not with criticism, rebuke or about their disbelief, questioning them abandoning and denying Him; but rather, with the simple word, "Peace". Jesus Christ then "breathes" His Spirit of peace and mercy upon them and "sends" them to breathe that same Spirit of peace and mercy to others - and "something incredibly new happens" - they do it!

This feast of Pentecost can become a memory of something wonderful that happened 2,000 years ago or it can become the "jolt", the "violent, rushing wind", the "peace and mercy" that all of us need in our confused world and in our confused lives

.The Holy Spirit of God has not lost any power over those 2,000 years, the Spirit of God is "breathed" into each of us precisely when we, like the disciples, are fearful, confused and guilt-ridden. The Spirit of God is called Peace and Mercy and has the power to jolt each of us out of our own little worlds into "something incredibly new" – but only if we accept, if we believe, if we follow and are sent.

"Something incredibly new has happened" to each of us today – are we "jolted" into accepting and beliving this new Breath/Spirit of Peace and Mercy in our lives and sharing this Gift with others? Or have we missed the "the violent, rushing wind" and go through this day, and our lives thinking and saying beautiful words from 2,000 years ago but never living the "jolt"
