- or you may visit our parish website at [www.sma.church](http://www.sma.church) complete an electronic Commitment Card

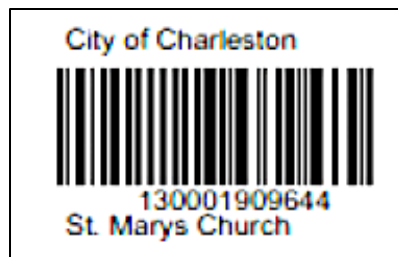
