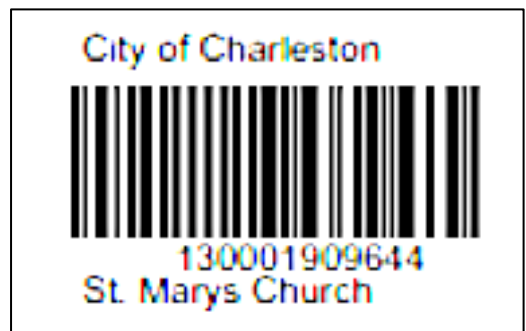
The new schedule will be available on "Ministry Scheduler Pro" after 5:00pm on Wednesday, July 24th. Thank you as always for your service to St. Mary's.
