All cards need to be returned to the parish by November 24th.

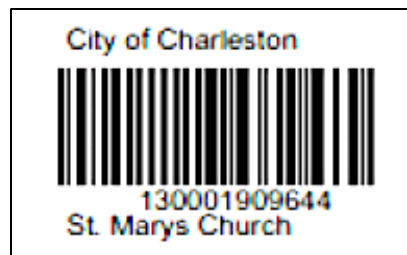
